Be at the shop by 9:15 for a 9:30 AM shotgun. Teams are drawn by the golf shop and the format is Captain's Choice.

### Friday Morning Game

Be at the shop by 9:15 for a 9:30 shotgun. The golf staff puts all the players in A, B, C, D order and draws the teams at random. The format is usually Three Best Ball of Four person teams with team greenies. An individual skin game is available.

All events are open to anyone that would like to play. All events require golf fees (which vary) plus entry fees which range from \$10.00—\$12.00.
